Rules for the Handling of Resolutions at Reorganization Meetings

- 7 I. **Action to be able to bring up resolutions referring directly to**
8 **Washington State Legislative session in odd years.**
9 a. There are times when important issues come up in session that
10 could be supported by the WSDCC, but without review by the
11 Resolutions Committee it is difficult to pass such resolutions for
12 legislative session when that year is our reorganization year and
13 resolutions are not discussed.

- 15 II. At State Party reorganization meetings, the members of the previous
16 Resolutions Committee who have been reelected to the WSDCC, shall
17 meet and consider only those resolutions pertaining to upcoming
18 legislative issues that are time sensitive, whether presented through
19 regular process or by caucuses at the reorganization meeting. These
20 resolutions shall then be considered by the WSDCC General Meeting,
21 with the Resolutions Committee's recommendation. All other
22 resolutions shall be tabled until the first meeting of the permanent
23 Resolutions Committee.

- 25 III. The Resolutions Committee shall meet after the caucus meetings to
26 review such resolutions prior to them being presented at the General
27 Meeting.
