

Support Closing the Sprawl Growth Loophole in the Growth Management Act

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washington State Democratic Party endorses legislation that will close the sprawl growth loophole in the Growth Management Act by setting a new effective date for actions relating to urban growth areas, agricultural, wetlands, forest or mineral resources lands, limited areas of more intensive rural development, new fully contained communities, planned residential developments, or master planned resorts as proposed in 2021 SB 5042, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Governor of the State of Washington and all Washington State House and Senate Democrats. And that it be submitted to the Washington State Democratic Central Committee for consideration at its January 2022 meeting.
